

Dividend Reinvestment Plan Unilever N.V.

Exchange ratio

Further to the announcement dated 4 November 2010 concerning the payment of the 3rd quarter interim dividend for the financial year 2010, The Royal Bank of Scotland N.V. ("RBS") hereby announces that the reinvestment exchange ratio (the number of dividend rights of shares entitling to the distributed shares) has been fixed at 132.19 dividend rights for one Depositary Receipt (or at the option of the Members of Euronext Amsterdam 13,219 dividend rights for 100 Depositary Receipts) and 132.54 dividend rights for one Ordinary Share (or at the option of the Admitted Institutions of Euronext Amsterdam 13,254 dividend rights for 100 Ordinary Shares).

These exchange ratio's correspond to a reinvestment price of EUR 23.3712 per Depositary Receipt and EUR 23.4331 per Ordinary Share respectively.

Based on the volume weighted average price of all traded Depositary Receipts at Euronext Amsterdam during 8 December 2010 up to and including 10 December 2010, being EUR 23.2530, 1/132.19 part represents a value of EUR 0.17591, which is approx. 0.5057% less than the net cash dividend of EUR 0.1768 per Depositary Receipt.

Based on the volume weighted average price of all traded Ordinary Shares at Euronext Amsterdam during 8 December 2010 up to and including 10 December 2010, being EUR 23.3151, 1/132.54 part represents a value of EUR 0.17591, which is 0.5036% less than the cash dividend of EUR 0.1768 per Ordinary Share.

The delivery of the Depositary Receipts and Ordinary Shares will be made as of 15 December 2010 through the bank or stockbroker where your shares are administered.
